

LWDN Named Tennessee's Most Prolific Trial Law Firm in 2009

Among the five year combined total for most trials, Leitner, Williams was ranked as the second most prolific firm statewide with a four year total of 57 cases reported, an average of over 12 cases tried per year.

Attorney James P. Catalano was ranked 4th in the most prolific attorneys list with 5 tried cases in 2009. According to the Tennessee Jury Verdict Reporter, "Catalano defended tort claims in a wide area ranging from Nashville to Jackson".
